BUYERS

You must register and get a numbered buyer's card. Winning bids will be recorded by number. You will pay for all your purchases at one time; either at the end of the evening or when you decide to leave.

SELLERS

All donated plants and items for the auction must be registered at the door. All proceeds are for the benefit of the Bay Area Bonsai Society's programming. The full auction price goes to the B.A.B.S., or members may choose to donate only a limited portion of the auction sale price to B.A.B.S. (please indicate this at the time of registration). Each item to be auctioned must have two (2) registration cards (see below). Make additional copies as needed.

You may establish a minimum bid for your items. If you do not list a minimum bid, the auctioneer will assume there is no minimum and sell the item to the highest bidder. Where appropriate, give a brief description of the item, including common and/or botanical name, source, age, date of last repotting, special needs, hardiness, etc.

All materials submitted for the auction are to be free of pests and disease. The auctioneer and auction coordinator reserve the right to group items for sale or to refuse unsuitable items. To save time, please fill out the donor cards below before arriving at the auction.
